LOCAL AREA AND ACCOMMODATION



- Lowani Beach is located on the northern shores of Lake Malawi. Set in a secluded bay, it is nestled between indigenous bush, cassava fields, and clusters of large boulders on a pristine beach. The villagers rely on subsistence farming and fishing, and are mainly from the Tonga tribe.
- Our guest accommodation consists of three stone chalets on the beach. There are showers and flushing toilets in a communal block.
- Three meals a day are prepared and served by our wonderful Malawian chefs.
