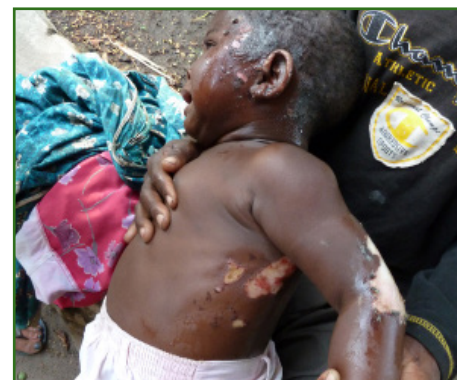


Changu Changu Moto (Fast Fast Fire)

Simple fuel efficient cookstoves that save wood and are safer to use

PROBLEM

- 95% of the population use wood or charcoal for cooking
- Most people cook on inefficient and dangerous three-stone fires
- Three bundles of wood are used each week per household resulting in deforestation
- Three stone fires produce a lot of smoke resulting in smoke inhalation
- Burns are common



SOLUTION



- Changu Changu Moto fuel-efficient cookstoves are built in every kitchen
- **Easy and cheap to build** – uses local materials and takes one hour to build
- **Saves trees** – reduces wood used for cooking, and uses one third of the firewood.
- **Saves time and money** – saves time collecting wood or saves money buying wood.
- **Safer** – less risk of burns and smoke inhalation.
- **Faster cooking** – two things can be cooked at the same time
